The job to be completed **on or before June 3, 2022**.

PART A Tendering Procedures

1. All inquiries, concerning the tender, prior to tender closing, shall be directed to:

- Notification of acceptance of tender will be by telephone and written form of notice, to the address of the Contractor used on the bid forms. The date of acceptance shall be deemed to be the date of receipt of the acceptance notice by the Contractor.
- 3. A tender may be voided by superseding it with a later tender or letter of withdrawal, prior to the closing date and time.

PART B Tendering Requirements

 A certified cheque made payable to the Township of North Algona Wilberforce in the amount of 10% of the total tender must be submitted with the tender, for deposit purposes.

Deposit cheques of unsuccessful bidders will be returned within ten (10) calendar days of the tender opening. The cheque of the successful bidder shall be retained until the Township's acceptance of the completed work.

2. All loads will be inspected and directed by the Township "Gravel Inspector" without exception. The contractor is required to provide a minimum of five trucks for each day of operation. There will be a \$500 dollar per day penalty for each truck the contractor is short of the required daily truck count. "Rain Days" will be permitted at the mutual agreement of the Gravel Inspector and the contractor; there will be no penalty for rain days. For every seven "rain days" five additional days will be added to the completion date. All trucks and trailers used in this contract shall be deemed in good working condition by the Gravel Inspector. Loads will only be applied to "prepared roads" as directed by the Gravel Inspector. The Township retains the right to sample, test, and inspect any load prior to application. The Township retains the right at any time to observe truck loading at the source at any time during the operation. Further, the owner can sample material prior to loading at the source. All loads shall meet the specifications as stated in appendix "A". The contractor shall supply to Township, before delivery of gravel, documentation that it meets specification in appendix "A". The contractor is responsible for supplying a grader (JD770 or equivalent) to finish grade gravel and removing any excessive windrows or pile created by truck dumping.

PART C Basis of Rejection

Tenders not conforming to the following requirements will be disqualified:

(a) Tender must be legible, in ink, by typewriter or by printer. Entries or changes made in pencil shall be invalid. Tenders which are incomplete, illegible, or obscure, or that contain additions not called for, erasures, alterations or irregularities of any kind, may be rejected

- (b) Tender must be on the form provided.
- (c) Tender must be signed and sealed by an authorized official of the bidding organization. A joint tender must be signed and sealed by each company.
- (d) All items must be bid.
- (e) Tender must not be restricted or modified in any way.

Disqualifications

Under no circumstances will tenders be considered that:

- (a) Are received after March 30, 2022, at 12:00 p.m. (noon) (EST)
- (b) Include tender qualifications or other conditions not authorized by the Township of North Algona Wilberforce; or
- (c) Are in the determination of the Township of North Algona Wilberforce, incomplete.

Right to Accept or Reject

The tender which includes the lowest submitted cost will not necessarily be accepted. The Township of North Algona Wilberforce has the right to reject any and all tenders for any reason whatsoever. The Township of North Algona Wilberforce shall not be responsible for and potential bidders shall not be entitled to, reimbursement for any liability costs, expenses, loss, economic loss, damages or consequential damages incurred, sustained or suffered, including loss of profit, by any potential bidder prior or subsequent to, or by reason of the acceptance or the non-acceptance by the Township of North Algona Wilberforce of any tender or by reason of any delay in the acceptance of a tender. Tenders are subject to formal acceptance by the Township of North Algona Wilberforce and a formal contract being prepared and signed.

Part D Acceptance

Award of Tender

Award of optional material will be at the discretion of the Township based on the Townships convenience and may not necessarily reflect the main Tender amount. The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. The Township of North Algona Wilberforce may, in its sole discretion.

- (a) Award a contract to the potential bidder that the Township of North Algona Wilberforce, in its sole discretion, determines is the best qualified and compliant tender; or
- (b) Determines that the potential bidder meets the best possible competencies; or
- (c) Not award any contract at all.

The determination of the best qualified and compliant tender shall be in the sole discretion of the Township of North Algona Wilberforce, which decision shall be final and not challengeable.

PART E General Conditions

1. Performance Evaluation

Failure to execute the contract in a competent manner may result in the bidder's disqualification from bidding on the Township's contracts for a period of five years (5).

2. Engineer, Authority, and Township

The terms: Corporation, Inspector, Engineer, and Authority shall be deemed to be the Township.

3. Omissions, Discrepancies, and Interpretations

Should a potential bidder find omissions from or discrepancies in any of the tender documents or be in doubt as to the meaning of any part of such documents, the potential bidder is required to contact the Township of North Algona Wilberforce, no later than five (5) days before the closing date. If the Township of North Algona Wilberforce considers that a correction, explanation, or interpretation is necessary or desirable, it will issue an addendum to all that have taken out tender documents.

4. Special Provisions

Special Provisions applicable to this tender are set out in Appendix "A" attached.

PART F Construction

Materials/Stockpiling

Granular particles must satisfy the requirements set out by the Public Works Superintendent and supported by a sieve analysis.

Where the tender includes application of granular materials, preference is given to tri-axle belly dump application although materials may be applied by dump-truck tailgate, providing care is taken to avoid segregation.

PART G Completion Date

The Contractor shall complete the listed work by June 3, 2022.

If the time limit above is not sufficient to permit completion by the Contractor working a normal number of hours, the Contractor shall make changes to permit the work to be completed by the above date.

Additional costs incurred shall be deemed to be included in the price bid for the works. If the work is not complete by the above date, or by an amended date allowed by an approved extension of time, then the Contractor agrees to pay the Township a sum of \$500.00 per calendar day, for each day's delay in finishing the work, as liquidated damages.
