### PART II RFP CONDITIONS

### TC-1 Completion and Submission of Proposal

1.1 The Proponent shall complete all documents pertaining to this Contract in ink or in type.

- 1.2 If the Proponent is a Corporation, an authorized officer of the Corporation shall sign the Form of Tender and shall affix the Corporate Seal.
- 1.3 If the Proponent is a partnership, a minimum of two partners shall sign the Form of Proposal and the signatures shall be witnessed.
- 1.4 If the Proponent is a sole proprietorship, the sole proprietor shall sign the Form of Proposal and the signature shall be witnessed.
- 1.5 The Proponent shall submit their Proposal by the date and time specified in Part I of the RFP.
- 1.6 The Proponent shall submit to the Corporation:
  - a. the Proposal and
  - b. all Addenda issued by the Corporation, with respect to this Contract.
- 1.7 The Proponent shall submit the Proposal on the forms provided by the Corporation and the Proponent shall submit the Proposal in a sealed envelope.

### TC-2 Deposit

2.1 A Deposit is not required for this Contract.

### TC-3 Agreement to Bond

3.1 An Agreement to Bond is not required for this Contract.

### TC-4 Addenda

4.1 The Proponent shall ensure that its name and address for receipt of Addenda are included on the Corporation's list of firms to whom Addenda to this Contract, if any, are to be sent. Inclusion on the Corporation's list does not absolve the Tenderer of its responsibilities set out in Section TC-9.1 of the Tender.

### TC-5 <u>Irregular Proposals</u>

5.1 The Corporation shall be the sole judge of whether or not a Proposal is irregular.

### TC-6 Unbalanced Proposals

The Proponent shall not submit an unbalanced Proposal.

- 6.2 The Corporation shall have the right to:
  - a. deem a Proposal to be unbalanced and
  - b. reject a Proposal, which it deems to be unbalanced.

### TC-7 Collusion

- 7.1 The Proponent shall not engage in collusion of any sort and in particular, shall:
  - a. ensure that no person or other legal entity, other than the Proponent, has any interest in the Proponent's Proposal, and
  - b. prepare their Proposal without any knowledge of comparison of figures with or arrangement with any other person or firm preparing a Proposal for the same work.

### TC-8 Right to Accept or Reject Proposals

- 8.1 Notwithstanding any other provision in this Contract, the Corporation shall have the right to:
  - a. accept any Proposal;
  - b. reject any Proposal, and
  - c. reject all Proposals.
- 8.2 The Corporation reserves the right to reject a Proposal of any Proponent who does not furnish satisfactory evidence of sufficient capital, plant and experience to successfully execute and complete the work.
- 8.3 Without limiting the generality of Section TC-8.1 the Corporation shall have the right to:
  - a. accept an irregular Proposal;
  - b. accept a Proposal which is not the lowest Bid, and
  - c. reject a Proposal even if it is the only Bid received by the Corporation.
- 8.4 Acceptance of the Proposal shall occur at the time the Corporation awards the Proposal and not necessarily at the time the award is communicated to the successful Proponent.

### TC-9 Contract Documents

9.1 The Contractor shall obtain and review all Contract Documents listed in the Form of Proposal and all addenda issued by the Corporation, pertaining to this Contract.

# TC-10 Errors, Omissions and Discrepancies in the Contract Documents

- 10.1 If the Proponent finds any errors or omissions in or discrepancies among the Contract Documents, they shall immediately notify the Corporation at the address specified in Part I of the RFP.
- No oral explanation or interpretation by any person shall modify any of the Contract Documents.

### TC-11 Irrevocability of Offer

The Proponent shall not revoke its offer until after the expiration of Thirty (30) days after the opening of the Proposals by the Corporation.

### TC-12 Successful Proponent - Bonds

Bonds are not a requirement for this Contract.

# <u>TC-13</u> <u>Successful Proponent - Workplace Safety & Insurance Board Certificate of Clearance</u>

13.1 If requested, the successful Tenderer shall provide the Corporation with a valid Workplace Safety and Insurance Board Certificate of Clearance, to the satisfaction of the Corporation's Solicitor.

### TC-14 Successful Proponent - Execution of Form of Agreement

- 14.1 Execution of a Form of Agreement is not a requirement of this contract.
- The Corporation shall issue a Purchase Order to the successful Proponent to indicate acceptance of the contract.

### **TC-15** Successful Tenderer - Insurance

15.1 Insurance is not a requirement for this Contract.

### <u>TC-16</u> <u>Successful Tenderer – Time for Completion</u>

- The Contractor shall schedule their work under this contract to comply with the following requirements:
  - a. delivery of the completed unit shall occur on or before:

(Proponent to insert date, <u>ASAP- In Stock if applicable)</u>	

- The Contractor shall complete the work by the time specified in the Proposal, unless an extension of time is granted.
- 16.3 If the Public Works Superintendent grants the Contractor an extension of time, the Contractor shall complete the work by the revised specified time for completion.

### TC-17 Successful Proponent - Liquidated Damages

17.1 A penalty of 0.5% of the contract price will be assessed for each calendar day that delivery of the completed unit is delayed beyond the time indicated in section TC-16.1.

### TC-18 Successful Proponent - Submission of Documentation

- The successful Proponent shall submit the documentation required by Sections TC-13, TC-14 and TC-15 within seven (7) working days of the day the Corporation notifies the successful Proponent that the documentation should be sent to the Corporation.
- 18.2 If the successful Proponent fails to comply with Section TC-18.1, the Corporation may, in its sole discretion, withdraw its acceptance of the Proposal and the Proponent shall have no recourse whatsoever against the Corporation.

### TC-19 Pricing

- 19.1 Prices quoted shall be the net cost to the Corporation and shall include all associated costs (i.e. labour, equipment, material, applicable licences, and permits) and all other associated costs required to perform the service to the complete satisfaction of the Corporation.
- 19.2 All Canadian Federal and Provincial of Ontario rebates shall be included in the net cost.
- 19.3 Prices quoted shall remain firm for the period of the Agreement.

### TC-20 Payment

20.1 Payment will be made after delivery and satisfactory acceptance of the vehicle(s).

### TC-21 Tax Status

The price quoted shall be in Canadian funds and shall include all duty, custom clearances and all other charges now in force.

21.2 Subject to Harmonized Sales Tax (HST), this took effect July 1, 2010 at 13%. Effective July 1, 2010, the schedule of rates and fees applicable to this contract will be adjusted to account for the HST.

### TC-22 Basis of Award

- It is the Corporation's intent to award on a total unit price as Proposed; however, the Corporation reserves the right to award on a line item basis, to the lowest responsive bidders, if deemed to be in the best interest of the Corporation.
- The Corporation reserves the right to disqualify any Proposal that is incomplete or is otherwise not submitted in strict accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Contract. The Corporation reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Proposals, should it be deemed to be in the best interest of the Corporation. Should only one (1) Proposal be received, the Corporation reserves the right to reject it.

### <u>PART I</u> <u>SPECIAL PROVISIONS – GENERAL</u>

### **SPG-1** General Information

- 1.1 The specifications describe a new 4-wheel drive, 150/1500 Series (1/2 Tonne) Truck, Gas powered, V8 engine, automatic transmission The cab shall be a 4 door crew cab with 8' (foot) box model with cloth seats.
- Bids may not be considered if the product on which a price is submitted, does not meet all of the requirements or the Bidder does not confirm compliance with all items by marking "YES" in the confirmation column or does not provide the required information where "SPECIFY" is noted in the confirmation column.
- Only the major details are listed. It is the supplier's responsibility to deliver a fully equipped unit, with compatible components that will provide dependable, efficient service. Where minimums are given, the unit must meet or exceed the capacity, size and performance specified.
- 1.4 Quoted units must comply with the following specifications in all aspects. Alternative components that meet the requirements but are not identified in the specifications must be approved by the Public Works Superintendent's Office, prior to the RFP Closing.
- 1.5 It will be the responsibility of the supplier to obtain any MTO Standards referred to in the following specifications.
- 1.6 The unit must be a new to current year standard production model, for the model year in which it will be delivered and must comply with all Federal and Provincial Legislation in effect, at the time of delivery.
- 1.7 The Proponent is responsible for all Warranty Service.
- 1.8 The vehicle must meet the provisions of the Canada Motor Vehicle Safety Act and the Regulations made thereunder, which are in effect on the date of manufacturing of the vehicle.
- 1.9 Please note that licencing will be the responsibility of the proponent but at an extra cost to the Township.
- The completed units shall be delivered to the North Algona Wilberforce Township, Township Office, 1091 Shaw Woods Road, Eganville, Ontario
