ENTRANCE PERMITS

Entrance permit applications are obtained at the Township Office, by emailing office@nalgonawil.com, by calling 613-628-2080 ext. 200 or on the Township Website under forms. Permit fee is \$150.00 and must be paid prior to receiving the permit. \$100.00 deposit is required with the application. (Deposit will be returned after completion of final inspection).

Fee for 911 sign is \$150.00, this includes post and installation, and must be paid prior to sign installation.

LICENSING YOUR PET

Applications can be obtained at the Township Office or by visiting our website www.nalgonawil.com, under forms. Cost: \$15.00 for the first tag and \$25.00 for each additional tag until April 15, 2024.

After April 15, Cost: \$25.00 for the first tag and \$45.00 for each additional tag.
