BUILDING PERMITS

Building, renovation, demolition, and septic permits are required before starting all projects. Applications can be obtained by calling the North Algona Wilberforce Township Office at 613-602-6101 **DURING REGULAR OFFICE HOURS**, in person at 1091 Shaw Woods Road, or on the Township Website www.nalgonawil.com, under forms.

ENTRANCE PERMITS

Entrance permit applications are obtained at the Township Office, by emailing office@nalgonawil.com, by calling 613-628-2080 ext. 200 or on the Township Website under forms. Permit fee is \$150.00 and must be paid prior to receiving the permit. \$100.00 deposit is required with the application. (Deposit will be returned after completion of final inspection).

911 SIGNS

Civic address (911) request forms may be obtained by calling the Township Office at 613-628-2080, ext. 200, by email at office@nalgonawil.com, or by visiting our website www.nalgonawil.com, under forms, or in person at the North Algona Wilberforce Township Office. Fee for 911 sign is \$150.00, this includes post and installation, and must be paid prior to sign installation.

LICENSING YOUR PET

Applications can be obtained at the Township Office or by visiting our website www.nalgonawil.com, under forms. **Cost:** \$15.00 for the first tag and \$25.00 for each additional tag until April 15, 2025.

After April 15, Cost: \$25.00 for the first tag and \$45.00 for each additional tag.

Open-Air burning is allowed 2 hours before sunset and must be extinguished 2 hours after sunrise. In effect from April 1 to November 1. Property Tax

- Interim is due March 31 and May 30, 2025
- Final is due August 29 and October 31, 2025
- \$10.00 fee will apply to EACH additional copy of:

 - √ receipt reprints
 - √tax account hardcopies
