1. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- a. All bid documents must be submitted in accordance with the location, date, time and manner as specified in the Tender.
- b. All bid documents and corresponding addendums must be submitted in a sealed envelope and clearly marked as to its contents in ink or typed form.
- c. As submissions are received, they are time and date stamped at the Township Office to ensure compliance with the closing date and time.
- d. Late submissions will not be accepted and will be returned unopened to the receiver at the time of submission or shortly thereafter by regular mail.
- e. Openings are a public process and will be held in the Council Chamber's at the Township Office 1091 Shaw Woods Road, Eganville, ON. at the time of closing or shortly thereafter, and on the date as specified in the Tender Documents.
- f. For Tender NAW-2025-03, the name of the proponent will be read aloud and recorded, and the total tender amount will be disclosed.
- g. All members of the public in attendance at the opening are required to sign the Attendance Form.
- h. Following the opening, the completed Unofficial Results Form and accompanying bid documents will be given to the CAO or Designate for evaluation.

The lowest and/or any bid not necessarily accepted.

North Algona Wilberforce Township reserves the right to accept/reject, cancel/re-advertise any Tender.

Project Description:

To provide approximately 11000 tonnes of Granular A (gravel) supplied/applied on selected Township roads. And to stockpile 300 tonnes at the Township yard at 1091 Shaw Woods Road. The contractor shall provide proof that is acceptable to the owner as the weight of product through load tickets or other printed documentation. The complete project is to be completed **on or before August 15, 2025.**

PART A Tendering Procedures

- 1. All inquiries, concerning the tender, prior to tender closing, shall be directed to:

- Notification of acceptance of tender will be by telephone and written form of notice, to the address of the Contractor used on the bid forms. The date of acceptance shall be deemed to be the date of receipt of the acceptance notice by the Contractor.
- 3. A tender may be voided by superseding it with a later tender or letter of withdrawal, prior to the closing date and time.

PART B Tendering Requirements

- A certified cheque made payable to North Algona Wilberforce Township in the amount
 of 10% of the total tender must be submitted with the tender, for deposit purposes.
 Deposit cheques of unsuccessful bidders will be returned within ten (10) calendar days of
 the tender opening. The cheque of the successful bidder shall be retained until the
 Township's acceptance of the completed work.
- 2. Granular 'A' extraction must be from a valid licensed industrial pit or quarry. It is the responsibility of the bidder to ensure proper operations and licensing.
- 3. The production of the granular 'A' shall be in accordance with OPSS.MUNI 1010 (Nov 2013).
- 4. The Contractor will be responsible for providing the Public Works Superintendent or his representative with sieve analysis of the granular 'A' materials (grain size analysis report). The results of these tests shall be provided to the Public Works Superintendent or designate five (5) business days prior to placement of granular A materials.
- 5. Should the Public Works Superintendent or his representative deem it necessary, additional sieve analysis will be conducted on granular 'A' materials at the expense of the contractor.
- 6. All loads will be inspected and directed by the Township inspector without exception. An electronic copy of each trucks load, gross, tare and net load amounts must be provided to the Township Inspector prior to offloading.
- 7. The contractor is required to provide a minimum of five trucks, three of which must be belly dumps for each day of operation. There will be a \$500 dollar per day penalty for each truck the contractor is short of the required daily truck count.
- 8. "Rain Days" will be permitted at the mutual agreement of the Township Inspector and the contractor; there will be no penalty for rain days. One working days will be added for each agreed upon "rain day" after the tender completion date.
- 9. All trucks and trailers used in this contract shall be deemed in good working condition by the Township Inspector.

PART C Basis of Rejection

Tenders not conforming to the following requirements will be disqualified:

- (a) Tender must be legible, in ink, by typewriter or by printer. Entries or changes made in pencil shall be invalid. Tenders which are incomplete, illegible, or obscure, or that contain additions not called for, erasures, alterations or irregularities of any kind, may be rejected.
- (b) Tender must be on the form provided.
- (c) Tender must be signed and sealed by an authorized official of the bidding organization. A joint tender must be signed and sealed by each company.
- (d) All items must be bid.
- (e) Tender must not be restricted or modified in any way.

Disqualifications

Under no circumstances will tenders be considered that:

- (a) Are received after April 16, 2025, at 2:00 p.m. (EST)
- (b) Include tender qualifications or other conditions not authorized by North Algona Wilberforce Township; or
- (c) Are in the determination of North Algona Wilberforce Township, incomplete.

Right to Accept or Reject

The tender which includes the lowest submitted cost will not necessarily be accepted. North Algona Wilberforce Township has the right to reject any and all tenders for any reason whatsoever. North Algona Wilberforce Township shall not be responsible for and potential bidders shall not be entitled to, reimbursement for any liability costs, expenses, loss, economic loss, damages or consequential damages incurred, sustained or suffered, including loss of profit, by any potential bidder prior or subsequent to, or by reason of the acceptance or the non-acceptance by North Algona Wilberforce Township of any tender or by reason of any delay in the acceptance of a tender. Tenders are subject to formal acceptance by North Algona Wilberforce Township and a formal contract being prepared and signed.

POTENTIAL BIDDERS ARE ADVISED THAT ACCEPTANCE OF ANY TENDER MAY BE DONE BY RESOLUTION OF NORTH ALGONA WILBERFORCE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL.

Part D Acceptance

Award of Tender

Award of optional material will be at the discretion of the Township based on the Township's convenience and may not necessarily reflect the main Tender amount. The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. North Algona Wilberforce Township may, in its sole discretion.

- (a) Award a contract to the potential bidder that North Algona Wilberforce Township, in its sole discretion, determines is the best qualified and compliant tender; or
- (b) Determines that the potential bidder meets the best possible competencies; or
- (c) Not award any contract at all.

The determination of the best qualified and compliant tender shall be in the sole discretion of North Algona Wilberforce Township, which decision shall be final and not challengeable.

PART E General Conditions

1. Performance Evaluation

Failure to execute the contract in a competent manner may result in the bidder's disqualification from bidding on the Township's contracts for a period of five years (5).

2. Engineer, Authority, and Township

The terms: Corporation, Inspector, Engineer, and Authority shall be deemed to be the Township.

3. Omissions, Discrepancies, and Interpretations

Should a potential bidder find omissions from or discrepancies in any of the tender documents or be in doubt as to the meaning of any part of such documents, the potential bidder is required to contact North Algona Wilberforce Township, no later than five (5) days before the closing date. If North Algona Wilberforce Township considers that a correction, explanation, or interpretation is necessary or desirable, it will issue an addendum to all that have taken out tender documents.

4. Special Provisions

Special Provisions applicable to this tender are set out in Appendix "A" attached.

PART F Construction

Materials/Stockpiling

Granular particles must satisfy the requirements set out by the Public Works Superintendent and supported by a sieve analysis.

Where the tender includes application of granular materials, preference is given to tri-axle belly dump application although materials may be applied by dump-truck tailgate, providing care is taken to avoid segregation.

PART G Completion Date

The Contractor shall complete **Item 1. Marsh Road** in conjunction with pulverizing operations, an estimated start date will be provided 10 working days in advance. All other items listed shall be completed prior to **August 15, 2025.**

If the time limit above is not sufficient to permit completion by the Contractor working a normal number of hours, the Contractor shall make changes to permit the work to be completed by the above date.

Additional costs incurred shall be deemed to be included in the price bid for the works. If the work is not complete by the above date, or by an amended date allowed by an approved extension of time, then the Contractor agrees to pay the Township a sum of \$500.00 per calendar day, for each day's delay in finishing the work, as liquidated damages.
