Building, renovation, demolition, and septic permits are required before starting all projects. Applications can be obtained by calling the North Algona Wilberforce Township Office at 613-602-6101 **DURING REGULAR OFFICE HOURS**, in person at 1091 Shaw Woods Road, or on the Township Website <a href="https://www.nalgonawil.com">www.nalgonawil.com</a>, under forms.

# **ENTRANCE PERMITS**

Entrance permit applications are obtained at the Township Office, by emailing <a href="mailto:office@nalgonawil.com">office@nalgonawil.com</a>, by calling 613-628-2080 ext. 200 or on the Township Website under forms. Permit fee is \$150.00 and must be paid prior to receiving the permit. \$100.00 deposit is required with the application. (Deposit will be returned after completion of final inspection).

Fee for 911 sign is \$150.00, this includes post and installation, and must be paid prior to sign installation.

After April 15, Cost: \$25.00 for the first tag and \$45.00 for each additional tag.

# Large Item Disposal – AUGUST 9 to AUGUST 16, 2025

# **ACCEPTABLE ITEM**

Artificial Christmas Tree (remove from cardboard box) ♦ boxspring/mattresses ♦ broken garbage cans, plastic totes, etc. ♦ carpets and underlay ♦ furniture (desks, couches) ♦ plastic – large, bulky household plastic items (children's swimming pool, lawn chair, outdoor toys) ♦ pool covers ♦ luggage and hockey bags larger than 9" x 14" x 22" ♦ mops, brooms, shovels, and rakes (non-metal)

# **NON ACCEPTABLE ITEMS**

Construction Material/Renovation Material ♦ Bathtubs, toilets, vanities ♦ cupboards, countertops ♦ sinks (non-metal) ♦ concrete ♦ drywall ♦ flooring ♦ vinyl siding, shingles ♦ windows and doors ♦ wood (lumber, plywood) ♦ wooden pallets ♦ hazardous or special waste – paint, propane tanks, etc. ♦ plastic flower pots and trays ♦ clothing and textiles ♦ leaf and yard waste ♦ tires ♦ bagged garbage ♦ cardboard boxes ♦ small items: (that would normally fit into a standard garbage bag)
